Current Children's Ministries

Nursery

A staffed nursery is available during worship each Sunday, as well as during many special events. The nursery cares for infants and toddlers up to age two. Persons dropping children off for the first time will be asked to register the child so that we have the information needed to provide him/her with the best possible care. A nametag system is in place for the child's security during check-out.

Sunday School

Sunday school Classes are provided for children ages two through fifth grade. Classes meet from 10.45 - 11.55 AM, with a Children's Worship Time from 10.45-11.00 AM. Our teachers will share God's Word and His love with your child in an age-appropriate environment. Children, ages 2 through first grade need to be signed in at a table by the gym entrance. Parents and children receive matching security bracelets for safety during dismissal.



Children's Church

Children's Church provides a time for young children to actively learn about God's Word. Two classes are offered during the worship service.

- Ages 3 through Preschool
- Kindergarten & First Grade

Children are dismissed from the sanctuary to go to Children's Church, after the offering. They must be signed in by an adult, at a table by the gym entrance, and will receive a security bracelet. Children remain in their classes until the adult worship service ends. If it is your child's first time attending Children's Church, please accompany him/her to the classroom to share any pertinent information with the teacher.

High Point

High Point is a Wednesday night program held for five weeks in the fall and winter for kids in grades K through 5. Each unit digs into the Bible and focuses on building Christlike character in a fun way.

ConNect

ConNect classes are taught by CMF adults to elementary age children in an effort to ConNect our congregation across the generations. During ConNect, kids can learn a skill, hobby, sport, or just have fun!

Vacation Bible School

VBS is an exciting, thematic outreach event for children ages four through fifth grade. It's often held in mid-June for four nights, each packed with kid-friendly activities to teach children about God's Word.

Church Library

The church library, open after the worship service, houses a wide variety of books and DVDs for children and adults. Children can visit the library after church or Sunday School to sign out items to take home.
