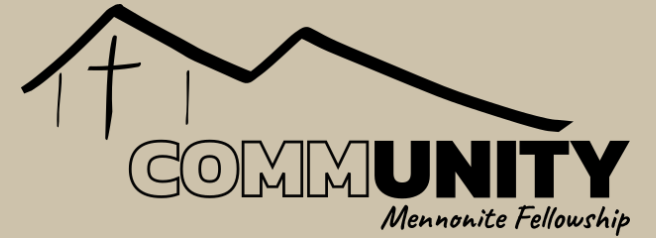

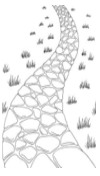

Signing in on an attendance pad allows us to minister to people who come in and out of our doors and to show care and concern on a deeper level. Please take a moment to sign in this morning!

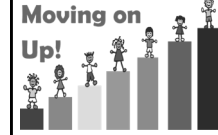
