Ben Hayes "A Sprig of Hope" Genesis 6:11-8:11

Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight, and the earth was filled with violence. And God saw the earth, and behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way upon the earth. And God said to Noah, "I have determined to make an end of all flesh; for the earth is filled with violence through them.... For behold, I will bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh in which is the breath of life.... Make yourself an ark of gopher wood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and out with pitch.... And of every living thing of all flesh, you shall bring two of every sort into the ark, to keep them alive with you; they shall be male and female.... For in seven days I will send rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living thing that I have made I will blot out from the face of the ground." And Noah did all that the Lord had commanded him....

In the sixth hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, on the seventeenth day of the month, on that day all the fountains of the great deep burst forth, and the windows of the heavens were opened.... The flood continued forty days upon the earth; and the waters increased, and bore up the ark, and it rose high above the earth. The waters prevailed and increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark floated on the face of the waters. And the waters prevailed so mightily upon the earth that all the high mountains under the whole heaven were covered...fifteen cubits deep.... Only Noah was left, and those that were with him in the ark....

At the end of forty days Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made.... Then he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters had subsided from the face of the ground; but the dove found no place to set her foot, and she returned to him to the ark, for the waters were still on the face of the whole earth. 
