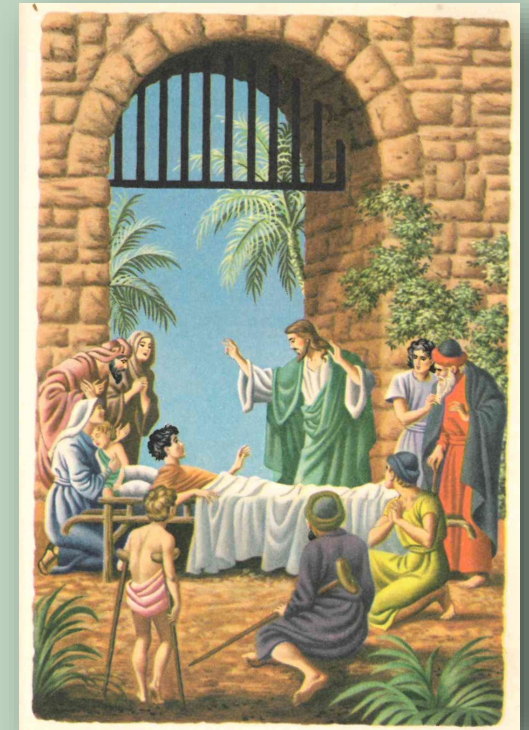


Immediately following the offering, we offer Children's Church for age 3-2nd grade.

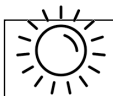
