Can you think of an example of a sin of a public figure that grew out of that person's control?

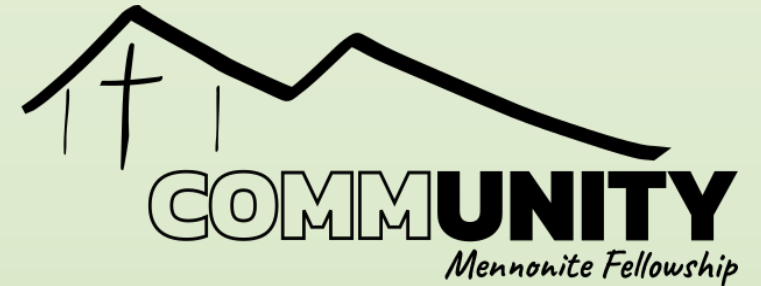
Not all personal sin will eventually destroy an entire country, but what has been a consequence of your own sin?

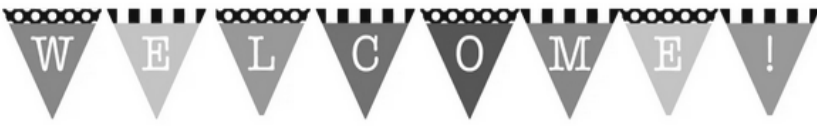
